



# R8 GOLD Outstanding Activity Award

## IEEE R8 Awards

### Objective

To recognize GOLD Affinity Group members within R8 for their efforts, success and achievements in carrying out the mission of IEEE GOLD and the aims of IEEE in Region 8 within their section during the calendar year of 2010. Recognition will be given to the most successful maintenance of ongoing efforts, and the development and implementation of new programs. These activities shall leave an important imprint on the section and on Region 8.

### Form of Recognition

The winner will receive a certificate providing the citation for the award and a cash prize of \$500 USD granted by the R8 GOLD committee to the corresponding GOLD AG. The award winners will be announced in June and the prize will be handed to the GOLD AG chair.

### Eligibility & Conditions

1. The GOLD AG must have at least 20 GOLD members.
2. Submission of 2010 annual report of activities.
3. Must not have received another IEEE award in the same year.
4. The \$500 USD prize should be used to support local GOLD activities.

### Nominations

Proposals for nominations of candidate GOLD AGs for this award shall be made by the section and supported by 1 letter of endorsement by Section Chair or designated person. The nomination must include a brief summary of the 2010 AG activities, the success of those activities and the engagement level achieved among GOLD members.

Award Ceremony – August 2011 (during R8 meeting in San Francisco)
